



Sundance Kid:

This cruise will take you through Sundance & Newcastle Wyoming and through both the Northern & Southern Black Hills. It is approximately 193 miles and features great scenery with museum stops along the way.

Here are the highlights!

Crazy Horse Memorial- The World's Largest Mountain Carving, dedicated to preserving & honoring the North American Indian living culture. Crazy Horse Memorial offers something for everyone with large museums featuring an extensive collection of Native American Artifacts, arts and crafts for the kids, seminars, laser light shows (at night), regular blasts on the Mountain, gift shop and restaurant.

Adams Museum- The Adams Museum & House was built in 1930 by W.E. Adams and donated to the city of Deadwood by the family. The museum features artifacts from the Adams family and details the history of Deadwood.

Termisphere Gallery- Dick Termes is a well known artist who's work can be recognized almost immediately. The terisphere gallery features a large assortment of the three-dimensional spherical pieces of art.

Sundance Mountain- The highest point on Trail Ridge, this mountain will give you a wonderful view of long peak, mummy range and the never summer range.

Custer County 1881 Courthouse Museum- Explore Black Hills history from General George Armstrong Custer's 1874 expedition to today. Displays include a Victorian bedroom suite, mining & industry, Custer's expedition, courtrooms, & the original Custer County jailhouse.
