



Whole Other World:

Western South Dakota has one of the most diverse terrains in the United States. From the dense Black Hills to the barren Bad Lands, this drive has a little bit of everything! The Route is about 113 miles and is another suggested day trip. If you are a motorcyclist this drive will offer amazing hairpin turns and plenty of open road for you to really cruise.

Highlights!

Crazy Horse Memorial- The World's Largest Mountain Carving, dedicated to preserving & honoring the North American Indian living culture. Crazy Horse Memorial offers something for everyone with large museums featuring an extensive collection of Native American Artifacts, arts and crafts for the kids, seminars, laser light shows (at night), regular blasts on the Mountain, gift shop and restaurant.

Harney Peak- The highest point in the Black Hills at 7,242 feet! Take the 7 mile hike to the top and view the Black Hills as only the birds can. Harney Peak has been host to many historical events including Black Elk's "Great Vision".

Stockade Lake- A relatively small lake with great historical sites all around it you can visit the Annie Talent monument or the site where gold was first discovered in the Black Hills. The water can be quite cool in the early and late summer season so bring a warm blanket to wrap up in after you cool off in the crystal clear waters.

Wind Cave National Park- One of the world's longest natural caves, named for barometric winds at its entrance Wind Cave is a natural delight. Among your standard stalactites and stalagmites Wind Cave has one of the most extensive boxwork deposits in the world.

The Mammoth Site- Visit an active paleontological dig site, with the largest concentration of mammoth remains in the world. To date the site has unearthed 61 mammoths and many other remains including a camel!
