Compensation: Performers receive \$150 per performance, as specified on the Performance Schedule Agreement, and based on the number of performances, not the number of people in the group. Special Events Performer rates vary based on the length and type of performance or event, as negotiated in the signed Performance Schedule Agreement.

Guidelines:

- Performers are invited to share their cultural background by interacting with the public and demonstrating their artistic process.
- Performers are expected to arrive at least 30 minutes before performance times.
- Performers are expected to uphold a 50/50 split between performing music and speaking, respectively, for every performance.
- Content of performances should be positive, educational, entertaining, and appropriate for family audiences.
- Performers should exemplify a strong work ethic, a professional demeanor, and positive and appropriate communications.
- Performers are allowed to sell merchandise including but not limited to books, CDs, artwork, etc., <u>but must obtain advanced</u> <u>approval from the Cultural Programs Manager</u>. A current South Dakota Sales Tax License is also required.
- Soliciting of tips before, during, or after performances is <u>strictly prohibited</u> at Crazy Horse Memorial.

Cancellation: Accepted performers must notify the Cultural Programs Manager, <u>on or before March 1, 2024</u>, if they are unable to participate for any reason. Notification after the deadline or failure to appear at the Crazy Horse Memorial as scheduled, could disqualify applicants from applying for cultural programs for 2 years.
