Performing at Crazy Horse Memorial®**

July 31, 2020 – Crazy Horse, SD

August 1st, 2020 at 6:30 PM: Native American rock music group Brulé will be performing at Crazy Horse Memorial on the Welcome Center Theater stage. In the interest of public safety, social distancing measures will be followed with limited seating for this Special Event. Masks are recommended for all attendees. Wristbands are required for entry into the performance on a first-come-first-serve basis, and will be available starting at 3:00 PM on August 1st, in the Covered Porch at Crazy Horse Memorial. All members of a party must be present to receive a wristband. Doors to the venue will open at 5:00 PM with ushered seating and social distancing enforced between parties. Once limited wristbands are distributed and seating capacity has been filled the doors will be closed and no further guests will be admitted to the venue. Standing or sitting in aisles will not be permitted.

Entrance to this event is free to those who have paid admission to Crazy Horse Memorial on August 1st and to those eligible for waived admission per the Memorial's policies. Entrance to this event is not guaranteed due to limited seating. Guests are encouraged to arrive early to ensure that their party receives wristbands. Crazy Horse Memorial cannot accommodate requests for advanced reservations. The cooperation of all guests in adhering to these guidelines is greatly appreciated.
