DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT

The newly created position Director of Development is an active participant in setting strategy and making strategic decisions in fundraising to grow charitable gifts for the purpose of advancing the mission and vision of Crazy Horse Memorial Foundation. This position will solicit annual, major, and legacy gifts and will be involved in seeking private gifts and grants, charitable giving at special philanthropic events, and seeking corporate and foundation support. The successful candidate will expand and diversify the Foundation's donor base and work closely with the executive management team and the development office staff, and other CHMF area managers and staff to secure increased annual and long-term funding for CHMF. This position reports to the President/Chief Operating Officer and is the named supervisor of the development staff.

A Bachelor's degree is required, Master's preferred, with a minimum of ten years of experience in business, sales or nonprofit management and preferably experience in nonprofit fundraising. The candidate must have a minimum of three to five years of experience effectively supervising staff and have a proven ability to influence and engage a wide range of donors or business associates and building long term relationships. The position is full-time/salaried, and will be based at Crazy Horse Memorial in the Black Hills of South Dakota and will require travel.
