Gift From Mother Earth Native American and Western Art Show and Sale

What: Crazy Horse Memorial's Gift From Mother Earth Native American and Western Art Show and Sale strives to highlight and celebrate Native American and Non-Native, Western Artists in a weekend art show. To align with our mission to act as a bridge and positive conduit between Native and Non-native cultures, artists can be selected from both Indigenous Peoples of North America, as well as non-Native artists working in the western and/or native inspired theme. This is a juried show and applicants are accepted to the show and sale based on the images submitted. A selection committee consisting of representatives from the Museum will review the images submitted by all applicants and select 20 to 25 participants for the Show and Sale.

Who: Open to all artists, 18 years or older, to enrolled members of state or federally recognized tribes, certified Indian artists, or non-native artists working in a western or Native-inspired theme.

When: June 17, 18, & 19, 2022 (Artists may begin setting up at 8 am on Thursday, June 16 with the option to sell when set up.)

Judging— Judging will take place anonymously at 3:00pm on Thursday, June 16. Juried art pieces must be submitted by 2:30pm. No submissions will be accepted after 3:00pm.

Reception--Artists Awards Reception will be held in the Laughing Water Restaurant **June 17, 2021, from 4:00 to 6:00pm**

Schedule—Friday (June 17) **8:00am-4:00pm**; Saturday (June 18) **8:00am-6:00pm**; Sunday (June 19) **8:00am-5:00pm**

Where: The Show will be take place in THE INDIAN MUSEUM OF NORTH AMERICA® at Crazy Horse Memorial, Custer SD

Art Show and Sale Booth Size & Equipment:

Booth spaces are **10 ft. deep X 10 ft. wide X 7 ½ ft. high**. Artists must provide their own floor covering, table coverings, and display units. All display racks, shelving, panels, work tables, lighting, electrical cords, power tools, etc. must fit in this space. Equipment provided includes: one 8 ft. table, two folding chairs, and basic electrical hook-ups.

Art Show Entrance Fee:

The Art Show entrance fee is **\$250** and **must be submitted to the Cultural Programs Manager by May 31, 2022**. (You may pay with a check, a money order, or with a credit card by phone). A limited amount of double spaces are available for an additional \$250 (\$500 total).

Cancellation:

Accepted artists must notify **Cultural Programs Manager on or before May 31, 2022**, if they are unable to participate, for any reason. Cancelling after the deadline or failure to appear at the Gift from Mother Earth Art Show will result in forfeiture of the entrance fee.

Guidelines:

- Artists will be juried for awards based on the overall quality of work displayed in their booths.
- Artwork submitted to the Show or displayed for the Sale must be the artist's original work. Imported, manufactured, or mass produced items will not be allowed. Imported jewelry such as stringers will not be allowed. Stabilized turquoise and man-made or synthetic stones or materials must be disclosed to the consumer according to the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990.
- Original paintings, drawings, hand-executed lithographs, etchings, photographs, and other original forms of printmaking are allowed; the method of reproduction for prints and photos must be clearly labeled, and images must be the artist's original work.
- Artists may sell limited edition prints and notecards featuring the artists' original artwork.
- Woven, machine, or hand-sewn and embroidered textiles are accepted. No commercial kits, patterns, iron applique or liquid embroidery.

Merit Awards: A team of qualified artists and independent jurors will be invited to judge the original artwork for the Show. Cash awards will be presented as follows: 1 Best of Show (\$500), 3 Honorable Mentions (\$150), 3 Merit Awards (\$75), and 1 People's Choice (Voted on by Public, \$300), and 1 Museum Purchase Award. Up to 3 juried pieces of artwork must be submitted to the lower level of the Museum no later than **2:30 pm on June 16, 2022**. 1 high quality jpeg image must be submitted no later than May 31, 2022, for the People's Choice category. Artwork submitted to the People's Choice must be included in the juried pieces of artwork and be present at the event.

Images: Artist is REQUIRED to submit three (3) images of work completed in the last 3 years. Submit high-resolution jpeg files by email.
