The Fall 2020 Wizipan Program Application

Final applications must be postmarked by **February 29th, 2020**.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements for the Fall Wizipan Program of THE INDIAN UNIVERSITY OF NORTH AMERICA®, a partnership between Crazy Horse Memorial® Foundation and South Dakota State University, are as follows:

- Preference is extended to enrolled members of federally recognized tribes; however, the university is open to all qualified students.
- Students must be enrolled in a degree granting university, college, technical school, or other higher educational institution in good standing.
- Completion of the application.
- Selected applicants will be chosen to complete a telephone interview with the admissions committee prior to acceptance.
- All applicants must complete the admission application and provide accompanying materials postmarked by February 29, 2020. Applicants chosen for admission must submit most recent college transcript by June 16th. If transcript is not received, the university reserves the right to rescind acceptance offer.

IF ACCEPTED TO THE PROGRAM

The following items are not required now, but required by **June 16th**, if accepted into the program.

- Official college transcript. Official means the transcript must be sent directly from the college to South Dakota State University. The student may hand deliver if envelope is sealed.
- Proof tribal membership, if applicable.
- Proof of Immunizations. (Measles, Mumps, Rubella; Hepatitis B immunization & Hepatitis B titer; Varicella/Chicken Pox immunity; DTP/Tdap; Polio, TB Skin Tests or QFT-G Blood Test)
- Proof of medical insurance and copy of insurance card and ID#
- Submission of Emergency Contact Information
- Medical prescriptions to assure adequate medication over the 15 week program.
- Recommitment to agree to Student Handbook
- Tracking Authorization (FERPA) signed form.
- Photo release signed form.
- Signed Computer Use Policy Statement
- Payment of \$50 deposit for a Room Insurance Deposit. Can pay at check-in on August 31st.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

A complete application package includes the following:

1. Completed application form. (Download the application at: <https://crazyhorsememorial.org/story/the-university>.) You may complete it online and print it out, and mail it or submit the application to IndianUniversity@crazyhorse.org. Receipt via e-mail will be recognized as signature.
2. Complete a questionnaire on your reasons for desiring to attend the Wizipan Program.
3. Proof of membership in federally-recognized tribe for preference consideration.
4. College transcript and current course schedule. Official college transcripts verifying successful completion of past semesters are required to be submitted by **June 16th**. An unofficial college transcript and current course list is acceptable to attach to this application.
5. One letter of recommendation. Letters should be written by those familiar with your college work and/or performance at your workplace.
6. Agreement to the Student Handbook.
7. Students will be contacted if they are chosen for a telephone interview.

Applications that are not complete by the February 29th deadline will not be considered during the priority interview and selection process. Students applying or completing their files after the deadline of **February 29th, 2020**, may be considered for acceptance on a space available basis after priority applicant decisions are finalized.

An admission committee will review all applications. Up to twenty qualified students and six alternates will be chosen.

All students will be notified in writing, by email, or telephone of their status.

Decisions will be finalized and students will be notified as the committee makes the decision.
